RESTORATION PROJECTS

(JC) – Locations are marked; it hasn't been warm enough to move anything yet. Moving these items will likely occur in the spring.

- b) Shadowbox - (HB) wants Shadowbox moved so that people are able to walk around the art piece.
- c) Golden Rod – Getting logistics: on hold.
- d) Vanishing Point - out for repairs, might relocate at the Gene Leahy Mall.
- e) O'mage – out for repairs, might relocate at the Gene Leahy Mall.

PUBLIC ART WEBSITE

- a) Zac was able to get to the bottom of the website issues. The website is facing a coding problem and not an internal problem so he is able to fix the problem pro-bono. There is a code based update he is able to do.

OTHER BUSINESS

Public Art 2018 Funds

- a) Public Art was allotted \$15k in 2018 for projects and restorations.

Korea-Vietnam Peace Memorial

- a) The City received a grant of 200k to replicate the Korea-Vietnam Peace monument and to restore the roof damage to the WWII Colonnade.
