

## **PUBLIC ART COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**

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CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by (HB).

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Minutes approved (HB) moved, (KC) seconded.

### **MIGUEL KEITH PROJECT**

- a) Mary Easley, Anita Rojas, and sculpture Dave Deihl presented more specifics on the bronze statue of former marine, Miguel Keith that will be placed at Miguel Keith Park located at (2902 Y Street).
- b) June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 is the date they are shooting for to unveil.
- c) The sculpture will be sitting up 18 inches on a granite boulder with rough cut edges.
- d) Veteran groups do a park cleanup/maintenance once a month as well as the Simple Foundation has agreed to help with maintenance of the park. Once a year the statue will need to be cleaned and waxed and the artist and Mary Easley agreed to do so.
- e) (JC) mentioned there will need to be an updated maintenance plan for the piece that will have to be submitted to the parks dept.
- f) Once this statue is completed, forms will need to be completed to update the public art website.
- g) (MR) will send Mary Easley the PAC plaque guidelines so they can use it on the bronze plaque being used.
- h) (RC) first motioned approval, (KC) seconded motion – unanimous PAC approval of the bronze statue.

### **RHINO CHAIR**

- a) Proper protocol of this piece is to get in touch with the artist to see if they or their family would like to keep the piece.
- b) (MR) will find out who needs to be reached out to about this piece.
- c) If the family does not want the piece and if there is no home for it, it would get auctioned. The family would receive no money.

- a) Golden Rod needs to be moved ASAP to a new location in the mall
- b) (MR) will get in touch with Brian Hartley about taking this piece to his shop and restoring it.

- b) (MR) was going to move forward with total approval from the City for having the PAC website under the city server.
