Hotline Report compared to last month:

- 41.9% decrease in service requests related to potholes.
- 10.8% increase in service requests related to abandoned vehicles parked on the street.
- 43% decrease in service requests related to weeds/overgrowth issues on private properties.

Additionally, the Mayor's Hotline received 852 phone calls and 318 emails that did not generate a new service request this month.
